NUTRITION AND BIO-IDENTICAL HORMONE THERAPY

APRIL 24 | Category 1A | CME Credits (8)

In keeping with our theme "A synergistic approach to prolotherapy, regenerative medicine and Human biochemistry" we are offering a preconference seminar on the regenerative biochemistry of diet,

nutrition and BHRT. This course will look at the biochemistry of tissue formation and healing including the nutritional and hormonal requirements of healing while at the same time, the nutritional

biochemistry for slowing of the biological aging process. We will discuss food quality, pesticides, supplement quality/selection, synergistic nutrient interactions, and Krebs Cycle foundation nutrition.

Participants will come away with an appreciation of various nutrient and hormone testing techniques from saliva to serum, Dutch Test to 24 hour urine, which are usable and which are fads; what is the difference between synthetics such as Premarin and bio-identicals; therapeutic vs. palliative BHRT; the biochemistry/pharmacology differences between hormone forms and what is truly healthful and why.
