There are multiple layers to chronic musculoskeletal pain, with the deepest physical layer being ANS dysfunction. In Western medicine, ANS dysfunction isn't generally recognized unless it has progressed to reflex sympathetic dystrophy (RSD), also known as complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS). The German physicians figured out that there is an entire spectrum of autonomic dysfunction, of which RSD - CRPS is only the most extreme representation. Neural Therapy is a system of diagnosis and treatment for pain secondary to autonomic nervous system dysfunction. Neural Therapy can frequently be used to treat chronic pain that is not amenable to other types of regenerative treatments.
